

Delivery Report for FSSAI Project under the Scheme of FOSCOS & FOSTAC
for month of November 2023

In the view of addressing the food safety needs of all types of food businesses at various levels in the food system, FSSAI-FOSTAC initiative since 2017 have been promoted and implemented through various stakeholders throughout the country. Basic, Advance and Awareness courses aiming to changes the food safety standards is currently delivered through a wide network of training partners, trainers and assessors.

The courses are based on general hygienic or sanitary practices as detailed under Schedule 4 of FSS Regulations. All kind of businesses have been covered under FoSTaC in line with Schedule 4 of FSS Regulations. The kind of business for which specific guidelines have been provided in Schedule 4, the respective FBOs are responsible to get their people trained in the respective courses. FSSAI has also created an ecosystem of food safety mitras who will help FBOs with licensing and registration through recognized and approved channel.

IEST Federation has been contributing the actively since 2018 in this drive. Covering wide area from Delhi, Haryana, UP, HP in North to Assam in East. In the year 2023, IEST Federation furthered its goal by extending its delivery in southern states of India, viz. Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

Following is the summary of month of November 2023 regarding delivery of both Schemes.

1. FOSCOS:

In the month of November 2023, a total of **79** cases for Registration and State License were processed. I am pleased to report that **67** cases were successfully issued. For your detailed review, a comprehensive report, organized by state, is provide.

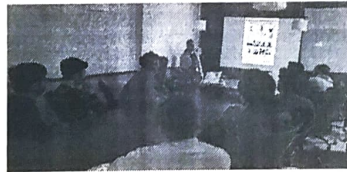
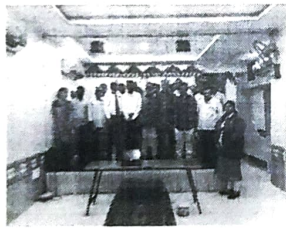
2. FOSTAC:
