### FoSTaC Program Conducted by IEST

IEST is a training partner of Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) for the Food Safety Training and Certification Program (FoSTaC). In terms of Section 16(3)h of the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 has to ensure training of persons who are or intend to become involved in Food Business as Food Business Operators (FBO) or employees or otherwise. FSSAI has made it mandatory for all food businesses to have at least one trained and certified Food Safety Supervisor for every 25 food handlers or part thereof on all their premises. To implement this policy, FSSAI has designed Food Safety Training and Certification Program (FoSTaC) for all food businesses.

IEST, as a training partner of FSSAI has been conducting FoSTaC program for food businesses across the state of Delhi. IEST has conducted three trainings for far for 53 candidates. The 4<sup>th</sup> training program is due and 23 candidates has already registered for it.

The 1<sup>st</sup> FoSTaC training program was conducted in the premises of IEST by FSSAI trainer of basic and advanced manufacturing, Mrs Aditi Kulshrestha. In the interactive training session she explained all the food safety norms and standards that has to be followed by food businesses.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> FoSTaC training program was also conducted in the premises of IEST by FSSAI trainer of Basic and Advanced Catering, Mr Amit Khanna. The trainees were assessed by FSSAI assessor Mr Dipesh Aggarwal.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> FoSTaC training program was conducted in Himachal Bhawan keeping the travelling ease of the participants in mind. The trainer and assessor were the same with the 2<sup>nd</sup> training program.

IEST is not only providing the FoSTaC training program but also providing certain other benefits to the trainees and their food businesses. IEST is associated with Council for Promotion, Research & Trade in Traditional Foods (CPRTTF). The Council acts as an intermediary and facilitator for FSSAI on various issues regarding Food Safety and Food Operations. IEST assured the trainees to have additional benefits from CPRTTF in the terms of Legal Issues, Technologies and Advisory from Food Scientists, Consultation, Promotion and an International Platform etc.
